"We need More Free Time..." That was the clear consensus from the business meeting of the 2014 reunion. So... the committee is happy to comply. This year you will find much more 'free time' to visit old friends in the local area, or see the new attractions that makes Las Vegas the international tourist destination that it is. For those more adventurous there is opportunity 'to get out and about' in the Southern Nevada area or even a quick trip to see or do something interesting in CA, UT or AZ perhaps. To help those of you who arrive by air, we are negotiating with a world wide auto rental agency to get you a good deal on a rental car if you desire one. And to peak your interest, we will even have a few 'folders' and website listings of interesting things to do in the metro and Southern Nevada area... 'Day - trips' if you chose... to some of the unique and beautiful state and national parks, or to one of Nevada's many old ghost towns. Or take a 'spin' on the 'High Roller' - The world's Tallest 'Observation Wheel'. In the metro area, you can also visit the National 'Mob' Museum, The National Atomic Testing Museum, or the Springs Preserve and Nevada State Museum, all are very interesting and a good value. Or you can visit a Chocolate factory that has an expansive and beautiful botanical cactus garden. The more curious can travel to Death Valley National Park and back easily in a day. So... bring your portable GPS, your camera and a comfortable pair of walking shoes and your friends WILL have a great time.

Las Vegas is changing... and better you hear it from your committee than finding out after you arrive. As the world-wide economy continues to struggle, casino revenues have like wise fallen off so new sources of revenue are being considered, and in some case implemented. For example, this month (June 2016), for the first time in history, locally, MGM Resorts has initiated charging for resort parking. Currently the they charge \$7.00 for I- 4 hrs and \$10.00 for 4-24 hrs. at all strip properties: these include the Aria, Bellagio, Delano, Excalibur, Luxor, Monte Carlo, Mirage, MGM Grand and New York-New York. Do largely to a ground swell of local resident opposition the MGM has recently modified it position to permit Nevada residents possessing a valid drivers license to enter an MGM resort for the I-4 hr period free. There your committee recommends you 'invite' a local Roadrunner to join you when you visit the strip during the forth coming reunion.

Those of you who frequently travel are very familiar with 'resort fees'... a practice that began in world-wide upscale resorts nearly 3 decades ago. A resort fee is a daily charge above the advertised room price and collected separately from the room price. At inception the fee was charged as a way of covering 'incidental' customer service costs... such as a morning newspaper, free local telephone calls, etc. The current Gold Coast Hotel Casino resort fee is \$15.99 a day.
